Each Pack must furnish 1 Den Walker for every 5 scouts attending camp and 1 Parent/Guardian for every Tiger Cub Scout (new Cubs who will attend 1<sup>st</sup> Grade in the fall). Example: 3 Scouts (Wolf – Webelos), 1 Tiger Cub=1 Den Walker and 1 Parent/Guardian; 7 Scouts, 2 Tiger Cubs=2 Den Walkers and 2 Parent/Guardians; etc.).

Tiger Cub Parent/Guardians may not be included in the 1:5. Two-deep leadership will be maintained in camp.

Adult Leaders:

The Boy Scouts of America require at least two adult leaders to be in camp with each unit at all times. We encourage one adult for every four Scouts but require a minimum of one adult for every six Scouts. (Many units bring one Adult for every Scout.)

Medical Forms:

Camp Tuckahoe requires all Scouts, adult leaders, and parents to complete a BSA Annual Health and Medical Record form (Parts A, B, and C). The pre-participation physical (Part C) is needed: For resident campers and for events 72 hours or more. This form must be received by the Pack 478 leadership prior to leaving for Camp Tuckahoe on August 1<sup>st</sup>. – NO EXCEPTIONS
